What has been the greatest challenge in your career at Ssangyong E&C?

The greatest challenge has been working with JV partners CCC and SP to carry-out Pre-contract work for the AED15billion Retail and Residential project to be developed at Dubai Creek Harbour.

This project is a combination of the worlds largest Retail precinct surrounded by 9 x 50 storey residential towers overlooking the Creek and new worlds tallest tower. In total around our development includes 2.6million m2 of built up area. Our work concluded with a 3 hour presentation to the client and Consultant team covering construction methodology, Logistics, Procurement, programming and even designing a labour camp for 30,000 labour.

Due to the size of the project we also included sub contractor involvement to make sure we could offer feedback from the market to the Designers and Client team.
